### **Requirements for all students**

All students enrolling at Virtual School Victoria require regular and reliable use of a computer/device that has a camera and a microphone and access to the internet. It is also recommended that they have a device with a physical keyboard to easily take notes and respond to communication. A smartphone, tablet or Chromebook alone is not sufficient to meet the needs of student online learning.

Where possible, it is recommended that more than one device is available if more than one child in the same family is enrolled at VSV.
